





Jersey Beach Sprint Rowing Championships

Four Nations Beach Sprints Round 3

20 June 2025

Location

Racing will take place in St Aubin's Bay.

The base for briefings, registration and racing will be on the beach in the vicinity of the Old Station Cafe.

The address for the Old Station Cafe is: Victoria Ave, Millbrook, Jersey JE3 1LS, Jersey

The nearest car park is lay-by 7 on Victoria Avenue.

Race organisers may move the location dependent on conditions on the day.



Event Categories

We intend on offering the following race categories subject to having sufficient entry numbers. Competitors may enter multiple categories.

CW1x

CO1x

CMix2x

In solo categories competitors may enter the U19 category provided they are under the age of 19 as at the event date.

Entries

The event is open to all ages, abilities and experience levels. Race organisers reserve the right to decline a competitor in the interest of safety.

Any competitor under the age of 18 may only participate with a guardian or parent who must be present for the duration of the event.

Race entry will be available via RaceNation in due course.

Entry price is £20 per person per event.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded for first place only and will be awarded on conclusion of all racing.

Equipment

Swift Racing/JRC will supply Swift Racing boats for all competitors. Competitors must supply their own blades.

Swift Racing/JRC will assist with provision of blades on request.







Provisional Program

The full racing timetable will be communicated nearer to the event. Timings may be subject to change.

Note should additional time be required some racing may take place on Saturday 21 June. If any racing is moved to 21 June we will endeavour to ensure that only CMix2x is impacted.

System of progression

The qualification process will depend on the number of entrants per category. The below is for information but may be subject to change by the Regatta organisers.

Where possible we will ensure all athletes have the opportunity to race a minimum of twice.

- 9 entrants Time trial course for all. Top 8 progress to quarter finals. Winners of each quarter final proceed to semi finals. Winner of each semi final to progress to A final and runner ups progress to B final.
- o 4 8 entrants Time trial course for all. Top 4 progress to semi finals. Winner of each semi final to progress to A final and runner ups progress to B final.
- o < 3 entrants Time trial course for all. Top 2 progress to final. As per earlier note if there are less than 3 entrants race organisers may combine categories.

After Party

JRC's Social Committee is organising a post race catered BBQ with entertainment on the beach following Sunday's racing. It is expected to start from 6pm and end by 10pm. Further information will be communicated in due course but tickets are anticipated to be c.£38.
