





Jersey Offshore Rowing Regatta

Four Nations Enduro Round 3

21st & 22nd June 2025

Location

Racing will take place in St Aubin's Bay.

The base for briefings, registration and racing will be on the beach in the vicinity of the Old Station Cafe.

The address for the Old Station Cafe is: Victoria Ave, Millbrook, Jersey JE3 1LS, Jersey

The nearest car park is lay-by 7 on Victoria Avenue.

Race organisers may move the location dependent on conditions on the day.



Event Categories & Medals

Event Categories

The following race categories are available in open, U19 and Masters (50+) age categories.

CO1x

CW1x

CO2x

CW2x

CMix2x

CO4x+

CW4x+

CMix4x+

Competitors may enter multiple categories but can only participate in one age category (even if being race alongside other age categories).

If entering the Masters category each rower (excluding cox) must be 50 years old at the time of the event.

Categories may be combined for organisational purposes. Where combined this will be indicated on the racing schedule.

Medals

Medals for first place only will be awarded to winners of each category regardless of the number of entries.

Medal ceremonies will be held on conclusion of racing on both Saturday and Sunday.







Entries

The Regatta is open to all ages, abilities and experience levels. Race organisers reserve the right to decline a competitor in the interest of safety.

Any competitor under the age of 18 may only participate with a guardian or parent who must be present for the duration of the event.

Entry will be via a RaceNation page which will be opened shortly.

Price per seat is £20. There is no charge for coxes.

Equipment

The Club and Swift Racing UK will supply all boats, oars and safety equipment for competitors. We will endeavour to make Swift boats or similar available.

Boats will be allocated at random unless a private boat is being used. Competitors may be able to change their boat to an unallocated boat from the pool however this must be requested from the race organisers.

Competitors may use their own boats, oars and other equipment should they wish but will be required to organise their own transport to the event.

Timetable & Racing Schedule

These may be subject to change once entries have closed. It is intended that all age categories be raced at the same time unless there are sufficient entries to run a separate race. Heats may be required should there be sufficient entries. This will be communicated nearer to the event.

Registration

A nominee from each crew should register with the registration team a minimum of 1 hour prerace.

All crews will also be required to check-in for their race as they are launching off the beach to the warm-up area/start line and must check-in when returning to the beach following completion of their race.
